We are deeply concerned that scores of people have been killed and more than a thousand injured, many by gunshots, amid violent repression of protests by security forces. Most of the victims are from historically marginalized rural communities and Indigenous peoples.



We call on you to:

- Put an end to dangerous public statements by officials that stigmatize and criminalize people exercising their right to freedom of expression and peaceful protest.
- Stop violent repression of protests that violates international human rights standards.
- Implement substantial, structural changes to end the marginalization, racism and discrimination experienced in rural and Indigenous communities, so that all people in Peru can enjoy their human rights and live in dignity.
